Dear County Executive Kamenetz:

On March 31 and April 1, your administration authorized the demolition of a home on Maryland Avenue and the destruction of approximately 30 trees at Bosley Avenue and York Road. Both properties are owned by Baltimore County.

The deforestation occurred despite clear direction by the County Council in Resolution 113-16.

As neither our office nor the community received notice, I am respectfully requesting that no future trees be destroyed at either property; that specimen trees at county-owned property in Towson not be removed at any point in the near future; and that no clearing of trees occur specifically at the Radebaugh Neighborhood Park as a design has not been adopted for that site. Thank you for your attention.
